I bring a client-centered, trauma-informed perspective to both my therapeutic practice and my approach to supervision. In my view, clinical supervision is a transformative space for supervisees to deepen their theoretical grounding, refine their case conceptualization skills, navigate ethical considerations, introspectively engage with the Person of the Therapist (POTT) dimension, and sharpen their counselling techniques.

My approach is deeply influenced by Attachment theory, with a particular emphasis on the interplay of emotions and somatic experiences. I have training in Accelerated Experiential Dynamic Psychotherapy (AEDP), Observed Experiential Integration (OEI), and Clinical Supervision. I welcome working with clinicians of various theoretical orientations.

Currently serving as the Director of Mental Health Services at Trinity Western University, I lead a counselling team comprised of both licensed clinical counsellors and intern counsellors. Following a developmental model of supervision allows me to meet my supervisees where they are at to support their growth and professional development.
